



Creepy Apple Heads

Parents should be the judge of how sharp a knife they want their child to use.

In advance:

Instead of a knife, use a jumbo craft stick (cut the top at an angle and sharpen the edge you just cut on a piece of sandpaper or with a belt sander) or a plastic knife.

What you need:

- Small, soft peeled apples
- A prepared craft stick, knife, or plastic knife
- Toothpicks
- Tissue paper
- Tray

What you do:

- 1. Use a toothpick to draw a simple face on an apple.
- 2. Start cutting and scraping away pieces of the apple. A good order would be to start with the nose, then the eyes, and then the mouth and chin.
- 3. Place the apple on a piece of cardboard.
- 4. Place the apple head close to a vent.
- 5. Turn and roll the head regularly.
- 6. The apple will shrivel up and turn into a creepy wrinkled head over the next weeks.
