

How to Download eBooks from the Spring Lake District Library to your iPad

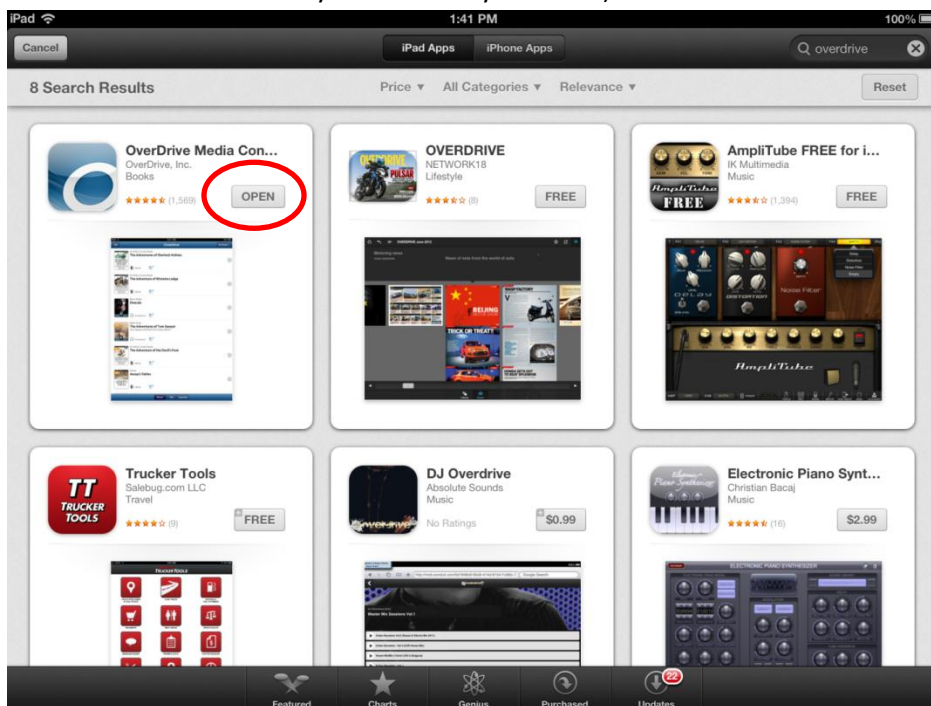
If the Overdrive Media Console app isn't on your iPad yet, first go to the App Store to download it. If you've already downloaded Overdrive, skip to the bottom of page 2.



In the App Store, click in the search box in the upper left hand corner and type in 'Overdrive.'



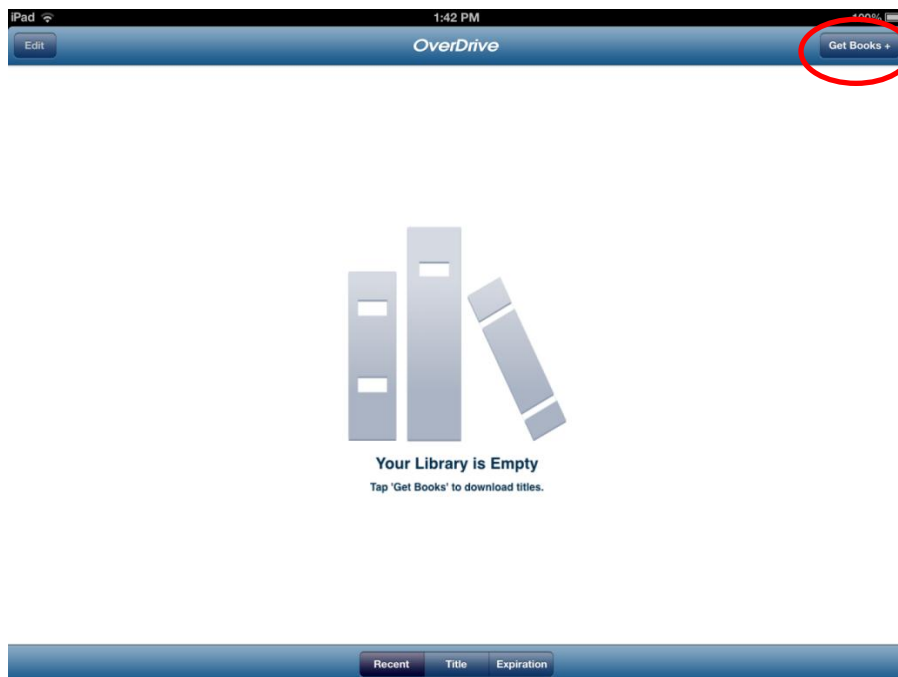
When the search results come up, you'll see the Overdrive app – it's free to download and install! Click on the button that says 'Free' then again when it says 'Install.' (Here the button says 'Open.' If it says that, you know that Overdrive is already installed on your iPad!)



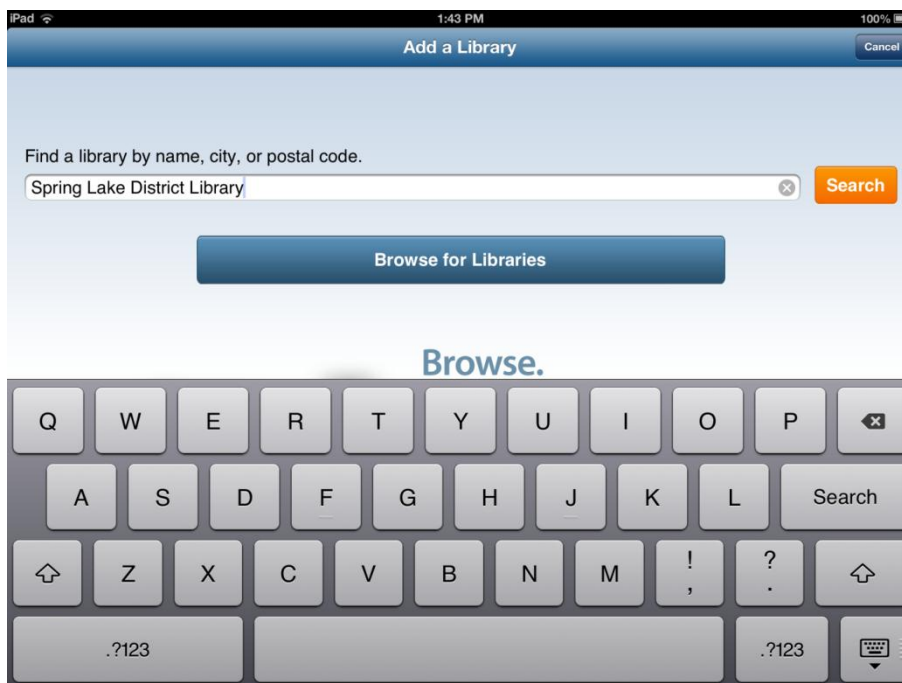
Once the app has installed itself, you'll find it on one of your homescreens. Touch it to open it up!



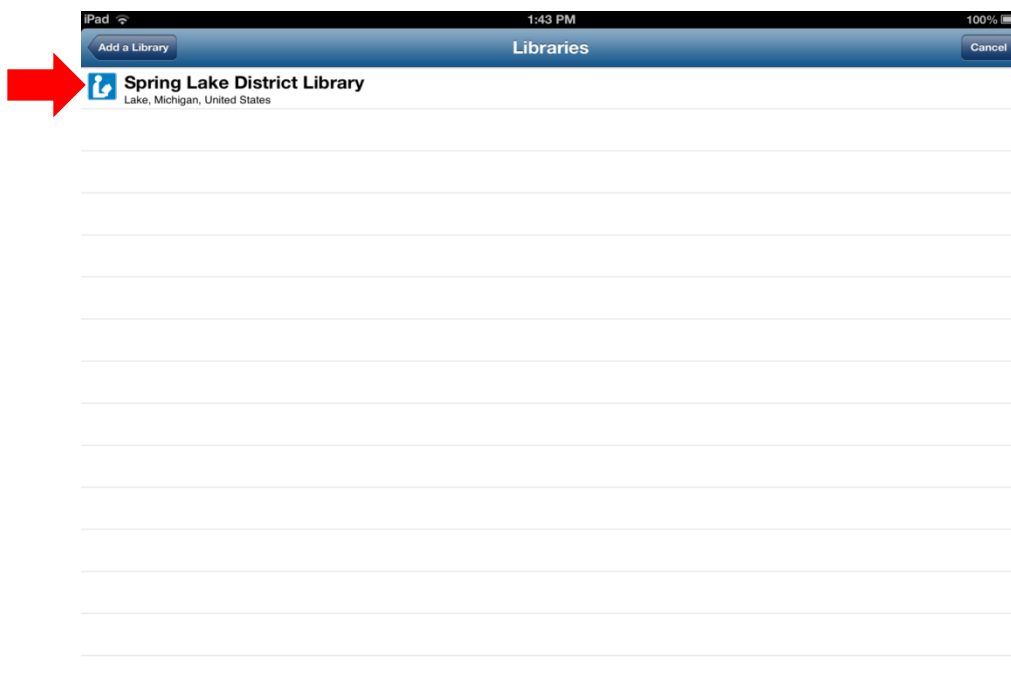
Now you have Overdrive open. Touch 'Get Books' in the upper left hand corner.



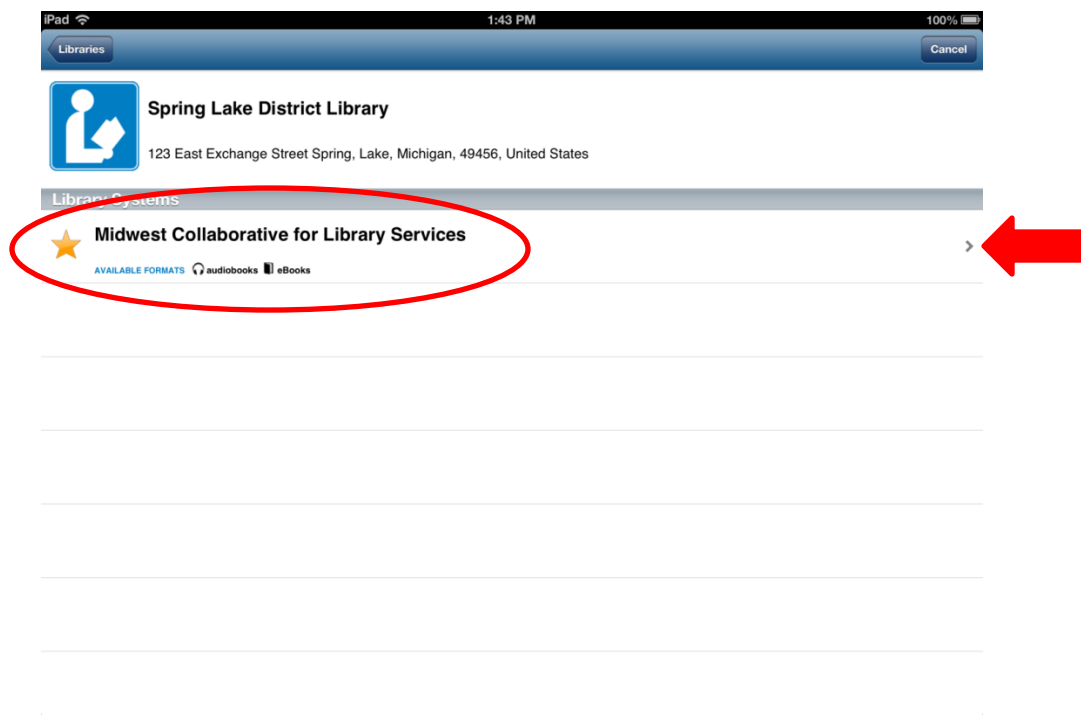
When 'Add a Library' screen comes up, type in Spring Lake District Library or 49456 to search for SDL.



When Spring Lake District Library comes up, touch it to choose it.



The next screen will show the Midwest Collaborative for Library Services. That's SLDL's eBranch. Touch the star on the left side to save it as a favorite library. Then touch the arrow on the right to go to the eBranch.



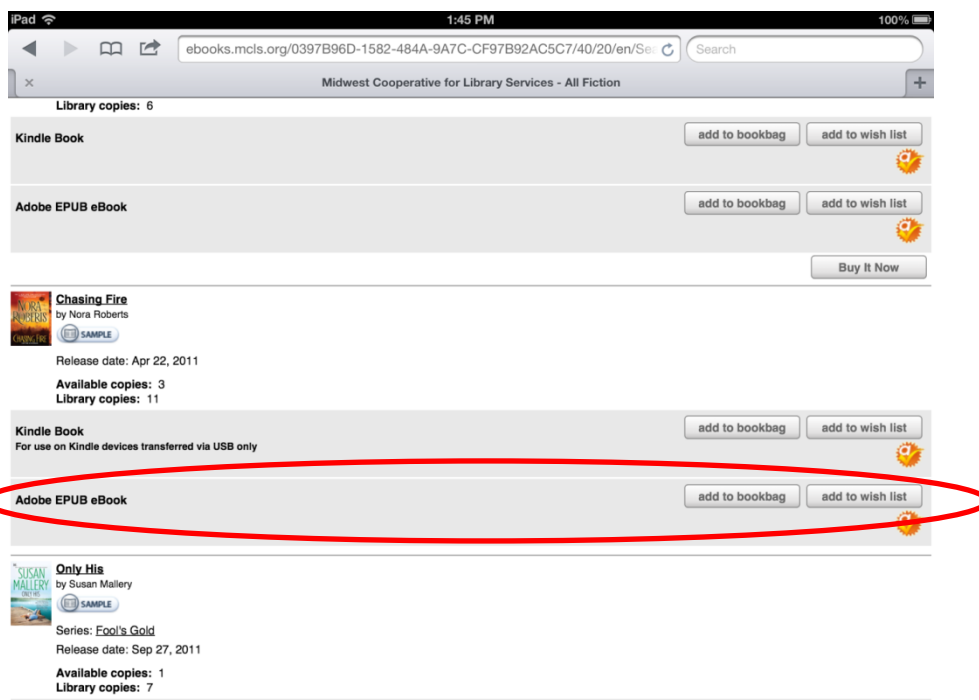
You'll be taken to our eBranch – from here you want to login using your library card and then browse for books.

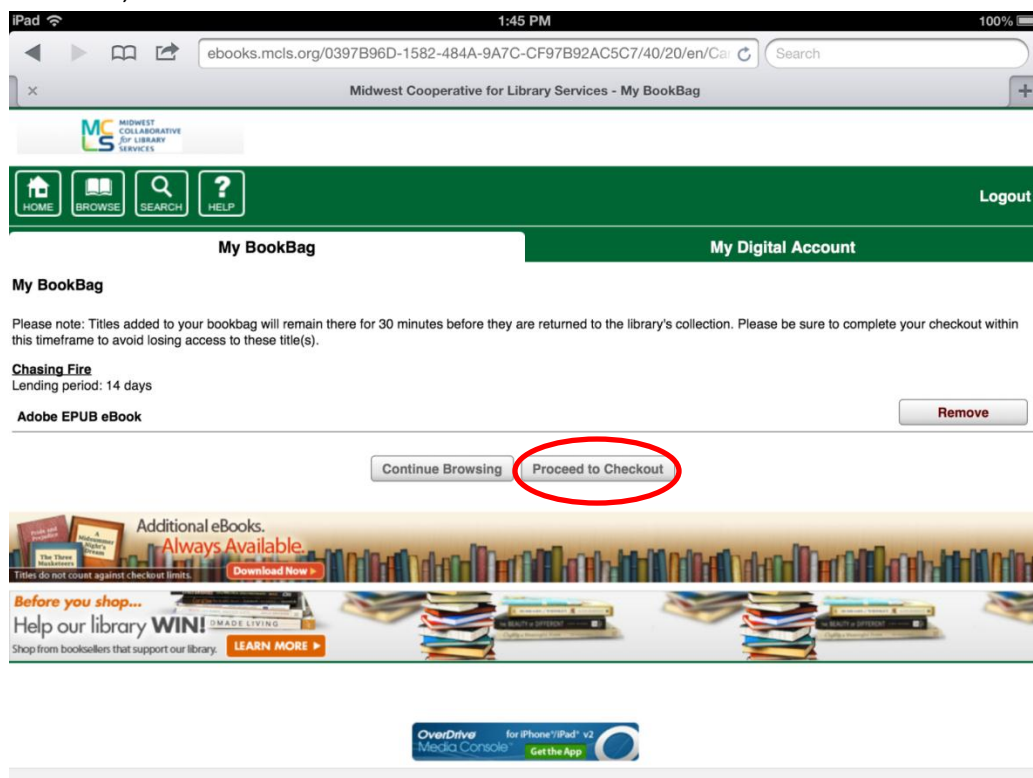
If you don't find a book you want right away, you can choose a genre and check the 'available now' box to only search for books available for immediate checkout.

The first time you download an eBook onto an iPad, you'll need to authorize your device to receive it. If you already have an Adobe ID (do you have Adobe Digital Editions on your computer or you've downloaded eBooks from the library onto your phone maybe?), you can just enter your Adobe ID and password. If you don't have an Adobe ID, you'll need to set one up. Touch 'Get a Free Adobe ID.'



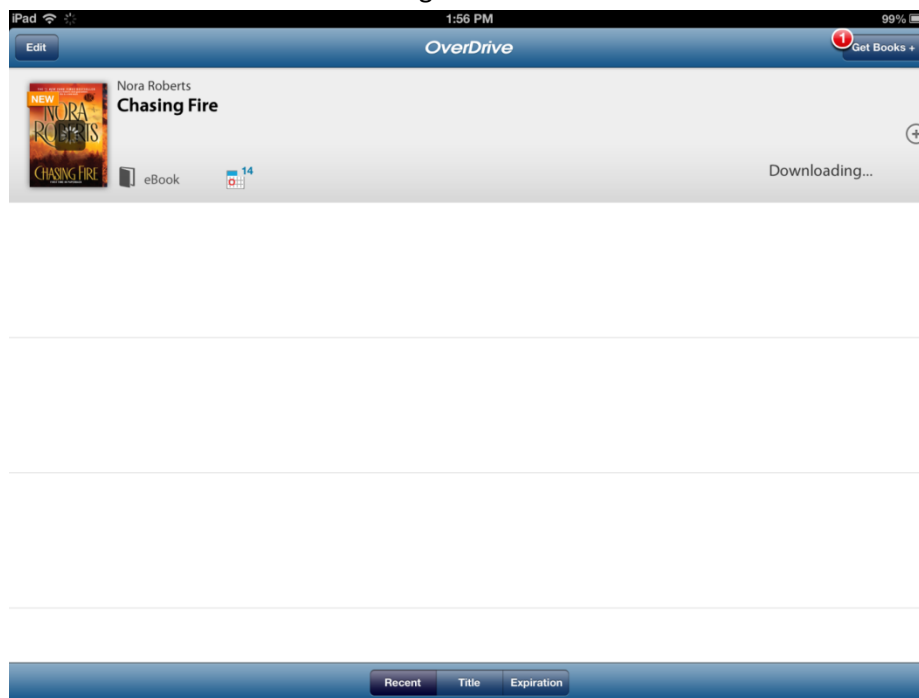
You'll be taken to the Adobe website. Here you'll want to touch 'Create an Adobe Account.'

To create the account, you need to fill in all the options marked by a red asterisk. (You can fill in the others too, but it's not necessary). An Adobe ID manages the digital rights and allows the book to be returned when it's due automatically.

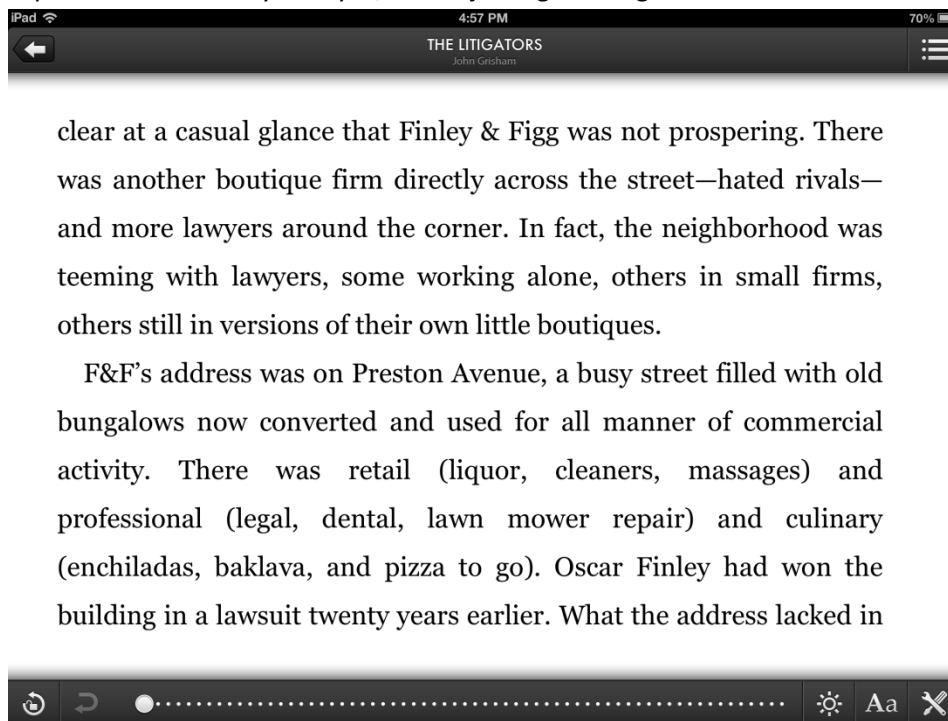
Once that ID is set up, you can go back to Overdrive, enter your new ID and password and click 'Authorize.' Remember – you only have to do this once!



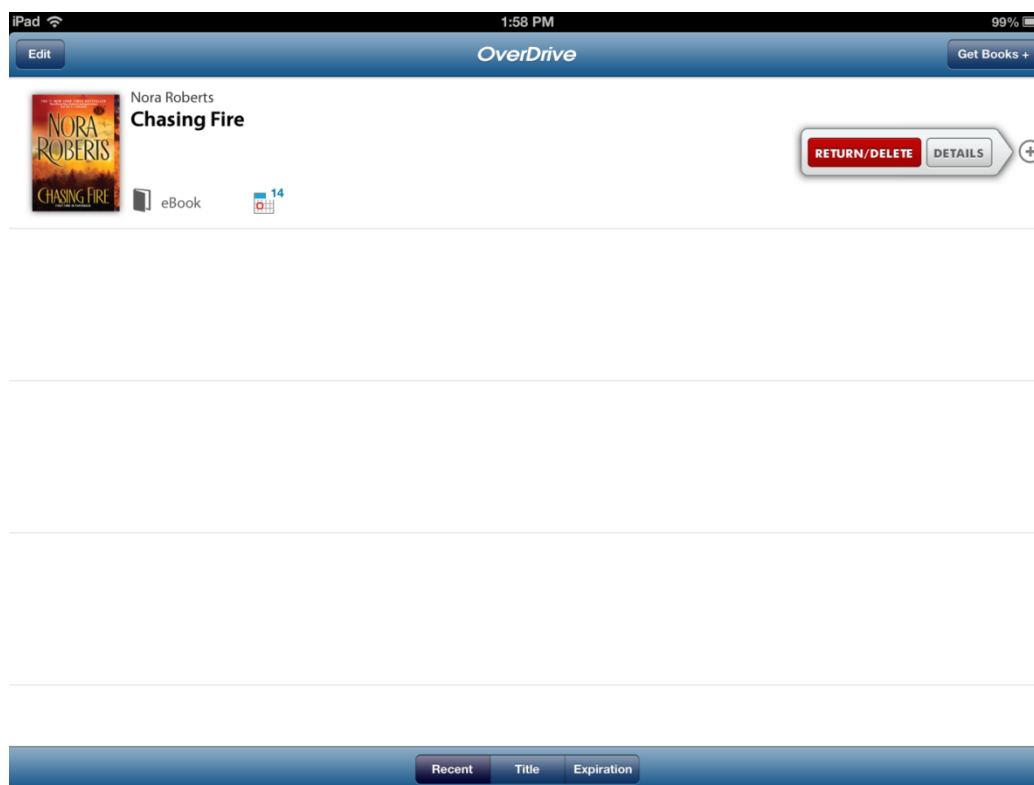
And congratulations! Your eBook is downloading onto the iPad!



After the book has downloaded, it will automatically open. You can turn pages by swiping the screen. Tap in the middle of the screen to see the options including changing the text size, turning the background sepia to be easier on your eyes, and adjusting the brightness.



If you finish your eBook early, you can return it early too. Just tap the + sign and choose 'Return/Delete.'



You've done it! You've successfully checked out and downloaded an eBook to your iPad! Congratulations!

If you run into any problems, you can always come into the library for more assistance.
