If you have finished reading a book and wish to return it early, you may do this through your **Manage Your Kindle** screen on Amazon.com. Any notes you take will be saved if you ever decide to check the eBook out again or if you should purchase it through Amazon.

After your loan period, your eBooks will automatically expire without you doing anything. Due to the high demand for OverDrive eBooks, there are **no renewals at this time.** You may place your name on the hold list as soon as you return your title or it expires.

You may have a maximum of ten titles checked out at any one time, and ten holds on unavailable items.

OverDrive Advantage Titles are additional copies of popular books purchased for use by Spring Lake District Library cardholders. The wait list for Advantage Titles is shorter than indicated on the OverDrive screen.

These instructions are for the **Kindle, Kindle Touch, Kindle Keyboard and Kindle DX**. There is a separate instruction sheet for the Kindle

Fire.

What Do You Need to Borrow eBooks?

- A valid Spring Lake District Library card.
- A computer with Internet access.
- A Kindle with Wi-Fi (3g cannot be used).
- Amazon username and password.

Finding the E-Books To Borrow

- Connect your computer to the internet.
 Open an internet browser like Firefox or Internet Explorer.
- Go to the library's home page at sllib.org. and click the **Overdrive** button on the right side of the page.
- This brings you to the MCLS Digital Catalog
 & Download Center provided by OverDrive.
- Login to your account using the **Sign In** link in the upper right-hand corner.
- Select your home library and then enter your card number in the space provided.
- Remember, you'll need a Spring Lake
 District Library card to download Kindle
 compatible eBooks from MCLS OverDrive .

The Search & Checkout Process

- You may browse for titles by viewing the book covers on the front page or using the menus for various genres.
- 2. Using the **search** function, you can also search for specific authors or titles.
- Use the links on the right side of the page to limit your search to Kindle format. You can also only view books currently available by using the grey 'Available Now' button. To return to all books, choose the 'Library Collection' button.
- 4. When you find the title you want, click on the cover of the book to open the book's information page. If the book is available, there will be a green 'Borrow' button. If it is already checked out to someone else, you may place a hold using the green 'Place a Hold' button.
- Once you click 'Borrow,' the book is checked out to you. To download the book, click the green 'Go to Bookshelf' button.
- That will take you to a page with the book's cover next to a green 'Get for Kindle' button. Please click on that button! You will be taken from the MCLS site to Amazon.com.

Downloading Your eBook

 On the Amazon site (if you're not already logged in), you'll be asked to login with your
 Amazon username and password.

2. Once you do so, your selected title will show up on the page called **Get Your Public Library Loan**. This screen shows your expiration date. Go ahead and click on the yellow **Get Library Book** button on the right side of the page.

3. At the next page, you'll be asked to select which Kindle device you wish to use. If you have registered more than one device, there is a pull-down menu . Select your device and then click on the **Continue** button.

4. The message you will see on this final checkout page is that your title has been delivered to your Kindle by Wi-Fi (Or you can choose to transfer it by USB cable) If you don't see the book on your Fire, you may wish to sync your device to make it show up. You may also want to confirm your Kindle is connected to Wi-Fi.

NOTE: All eBooks from **Penguin Publishing** must be downloaded from the Amazon site using your USB cable connected to your computer, even if you have a Kindle Fire.

Copy the downloaded file from your computer to the **Documents folder** on your Kindle.
