Bring your friends for board games, snacks, and time to hang out.

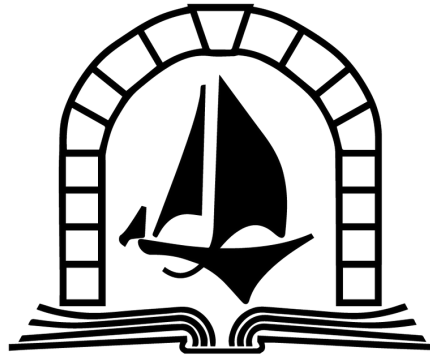
Teen 'Scape – Thursday, June 27 at 2:00pm

Work with a team to solve the puzzle and uncover the prize. Registration required—Limit 20.

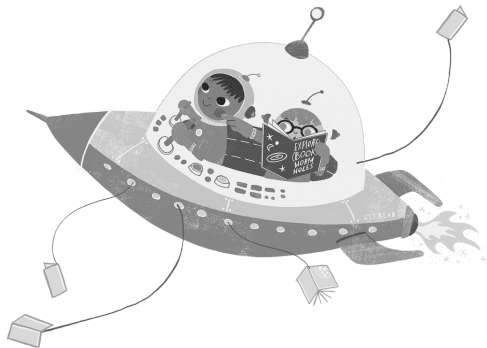
