Unattended Conveyances Policy

To promote the safety of all people using the library as well as the security of the items involved, all unattended conveyances must be properly secured or must comply with the requirements listed below while on library property.

Motorized vehicles including automobiles, motorcycles, and mopeds must be parked in a marked parking space in the parking lot. Motorized wheelchairs, motorized scooters, or other mobility devices used by patrons inside the Library but left temporarily unattended may not block or impair access to exits/entrances, bathrooms, or other doorways, and may not impede access to library materials by other patrons. Any motorized wheelchairs, motorized scooters or other mobility devices left unattended in violation of this policy may be moved by Library staff if necessary.

Skateboards, rollerblades and wheelies may not be used in the library or on the premises. Strollers, jogging strollers, wagons, tricycles or big wheels used by patrons in the Library or outside the Library that are left temporarily unattended may not block or impair access to exits/entrances, bathrooms, other doorways, sidewalks or the parking lot and may not impede access to library materials by other patrons. Those devices left unattended in violation of this policy may be moved by library staff.

The Library Board strongly recommends that all owners of conveyances described above properly secure their property or keep them close by when using the library.
